PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Rosebud Sioux Tribe is soliciting proposals for easement acquisition and engineering design services for the Two Strike Community Pathway Project. Currently, this segment of BIA Route 1 lacks any pedestrian infrastructure. The proposed pathway is intended to provide a critical link between the Two Strike Community and Cherry Avenue in St. Francis.

TECRO FEE

INDIAN PREFERENCE

Indian enterprises/organizations must prequalify for Indian preference by first submitting evidence of Indian ownership and control to the RST TECRO Office no later than one week prior to the proposal opening. BUSINESS LICENSE and DEBARMENT CERTIFICATION
