PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Rosebud Sioux Tribe (RST) Transportation Program is initiating a project to plan and install ten (10) permanent speed feedback signs across the Rosebud Reservation. These signs are intended to provide real-time feedback to motorists in identified high-speed areas and school zones to deter speeding, which has been identified as a primary cause of motor vehicle crashes on the reservation.

PROJECT OBJECTIVES

- Safety Deterrence: Utilize radar feedback to reduce vehicle speeds in critical safety areas.
- Data Collection: Support tribal efforts in collecting speed data and assessing areas of high speed for future targeted education and enforcement.
- Infrastructure Durability: Implement permanent signage as a more cost-effective and durable solution compared to temporary portable signs.

CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES AND TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Equipment Standards: Based on recent bid data for comparable safety signage, unit costs typically vary from \$8,000 to \$13,600, contingent upon specific speed feedback capabilities.
- Regulatory Compliance: Guarantee that all infrastructure installations satisfy criteria for permanent roadside assets in accordance with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) administers the current 11th Edition of the National MUTCD.
- Location Planning: Collaborate with the RST Transportation Program to establish exact sign placement, utilizing community input and the latest safety data.

TECRO FEE

Include 4.5% TECRO fee in proposal.

Submit 10 bound proposals sealed and marked on the outside: **“RFP No. 26-29-Permanent Speed Feedback Signs.”** Failure to do so will result in a proposal being non-responsive and the proposal returned unopened. The Tribe will not accept email, fax, or telephone proposals. **Proposals will be accepted until 4:30p.m. (CST) on August 5, 2026.** Proposals received after this time will not be accepted.

INDIAN PREFERENCE

Indian enterprises and organizations must prequalify for Indian preference by first submitting evidence of Indian ownership and control to the RST TECRO Office no later than one week prior to the proposal opening. BUSINESS LICENSE and DEBARMENT CERTIFICATION

Provide copy of RST business license. Provide a current, not to exceed 1 year, proof of suspension debarment certification. Obtained from the U.S. GSA System for Award Management (SAM).
